

Pre-TAVR Checklist

You are undergoing workup for aortic valve replacement. To safely plan your procedure, the following items are crucial:

- Consultation with a structural cardiologist
 - Consultation with a Cardiac Surgeon
 - Echocardiogram or Heart Ultrasound
 - To establish the severity of your valve abnormality
 - Carotid Ultrasound
 - Coronary angiogram and possible stent placement
 - To ensure your heart has adequate blood flow at the time of your valve replacement
 - Specialized TAVR CT Scan
 - To determine the size of your heart valve and the best way to deliver the valve to your heart
 - Other testing based on your unique anatomy/physiology
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We will help you schedule all of the above.

After the above items are complete, your case will be discussed at our multidisciplinary Valve Conference. We will then contact you to present your options and/or schedule your procedure.

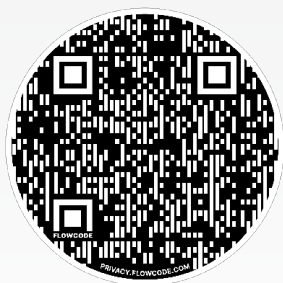
Post-TAVR Checklist

- Post operative visit 1-2 weeks post procedure
- Echocardiogram within 30-75 days post procedure
- Post operative visit 1 year post procedure
