THE AGING HEART



Coronary Artery Disease Blood vessels that supply oxygen to the heart get clogged over time

Medications: Statins



Atrial Fibrillation

Electrical impulses that make the heart beat wear out over time causing irregular heart rate

Medications: Blood thinners, Metoprolol, Coreg, Amiodarone



Heart Murmurs

Heart valves don't close all the way so there is leaking which causes a murmur

Medications: Blood Thinners



Congestive Heart Failure

The heart muscle weakens over time and doesn't squeeze out as much blood with each beat causing swelling in feet, legs, belly or around the lungs

Medications:
Beta blockers help the heart contract
harder to squeeze out more blood
Water pills to rid the body of excess fluid
Other blood pressure and heart medications
